Old Business:

Camera Installation:

Brittany has not received the quote for the library basement camera installation. Brittany
advises it would be a better option to install cameras in the senior center due to the larger size
as well as the server being located in the slade building. Brittany states the installation estimate
would be at least \$5,000 higher in the library vs the senior center due to the complexity. The
Board will invite the Conservation Commission, Board of Health and Council on Aging it the next

New Business:

Town Meeting Sound System:

• The committee has received feedback in regards to the sound system at Town Meeting. Residents expressed it was difficult to hear some of the comments or questions that were raised. Brittany states the issue is not with the sound system, it is with the way the microphone is being held. Tom Robinson advised there are various types of microphones and suggested a new, more user friendly microphone might be a positive solution. A slide projector as well as podium location were discussed.

School Events:

• Brittany spoke with the Principal at Center School to discuss the recording of upcoming events at the school. The principal advised events cannot be videotaped due to the lack of consent by parents. Brittany discussed options of videotaping to include removing children from the videos or the option to blur faces.
