We meet the first and third Wednesday of the month at 1:00 p.m. New members are always welcomed.



TOWN NEWS

2022 Census and Dog Licenses have been mailed! Included with the census, you will find the 2022 Burn Permit and the 2022 Dog License Renewal. Please note, separate checks need to be written for burn permits and dog licenses as they are processed by different departments however, they can be mailed in together.

For dog licensing, please be sure to send in a copy of current rabies (if we do not already have one on file) along with a self-addressed stamped envelope for processing. Please be sure to update us if you no longer have a previously registered dog so we can update our files accordingly. Under State and local laws, all dogs by the age of 6 months must be licensed with the Town and have a valid rabies vaccination. Dogs not licensed by May 1 will be charged a \$25 late fee. Any collection of more than 4 dogs kept for any purpose requires a Special Permit from the Planning Board.

Census forms should be updated accordingly and returned at your earliest convenience. Please note: Per MGL Ch. 51, Sec. 4(c) failure to respond to the annual census for 2 consecutive years shall result in removal from the active voter list. The Census form **DOES**NOT register you as a voter or allow you to change your political party. 

Sugar Cookie S'mores

Ingredients

8 Fun size Milky Way candy bars

8 sugar cookies

4 large marshmallows

Directions

Place 2 candy bars on each of 4 cookies; place on grill rack. Grill, uncovered, over medium-hot heat for 1 to 1-1/2 minutes or until bottoms of cookies are browned.

Meanwhile, using a long-handled fork, toast marshmallows 6 in. from the heat until golden brown, turning occasionally. Remove marshmallows from fork and place over candy bars; top with remaining cookies. Serve immediately.


Medical Appointments: Available as needed


The Outhouse will be located on Williamsville Rd at The Country Hen pond starting in February.


