

# Celebrate the 4th of July With a Patriotic Trifle in a Jar

### ingredients


2 store bought pound cakes

1 pint blueberries

1 pint raspberries

<u>homemade whipped</u>
<u>cream</u> (heavy cream, vanilla extract and sugar)





Slice the cake into pieces that are about 1 inch thick, and then use round cookie cutters to cut the cake into rounds. I found that I needed a slightly smaller size for the bottom layer than the top since the jars are tapered. If you don't have round cookie cutters, cutting the cake up into cubes would work as well.

Start with a cake layer on the bottom. Then just layer your berries and whipped cream to create a red, white and blue effect. Top with another

cake round and a dollop of whipped cream. Garnish with extra berries if desired.


