












IMPORTANT NEWS ABOUT YOUR MEDICARE DRUG AND HEALTH PLANS

It's that time of year again! If you have a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO, PPO), your Plan will mail you an information packet called an ANNUAL NOTICE OF CHANGE by the end of September. It is important to understand and save this information because it explains the changes in your plan for 2022. Your plan premiums, deductibles, copays, providers and covered drugs may change significantly!

During the annual Medicare Open Enrollment Period (October 15th - December 7th), you have a chance to CHANGE your plan for next year. SHINE's certified Medicare counselors can help you understand your plan changes, as well as other options you may have. Trained SHINE (Serving Health Information Needs of Everyone) counselors can help you! We offer free unbiased, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on Medicare. Call your Hubbardston Senior Center (978-928-1400 ×211) and ask for a SHINE appointment.




FALL SPECIAL TOWN MEETING



Scam Alert






