

Medicare Open Enrollment

Open Enrollment runs from October 15th through December 7th. During this time, you can change your Medicare Plan effective January 1st. Contact the Senior Center to speak with a SHINE counsellor in person or over the phone. SHINE (Serving the Health Insurance Needs of Everyone) has certified counselors to help you with questions about Medicare. Our services are free and unbiased. We are available to discuss all options related to Medicare and additional coverage, and we do not sell any plans.

Senior Tax Work-Off Program applications are now available at the Senior Center. This programs runs from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023.

Cranberry Brie Bites

Ingredients

- 1 (8-oz.) tube crescent dough
- Cooking spray, for pan
- Flour, for surface
- 1 (8-oz.) wheel of brie
- 1/2 c. whole berry cranberry sauce
- 1/4 c. chopped pecans

6 sprigs of rosemary, cut into 1" pieces.



Directions

Step 1 Preheat oven to 375° and grease a mini muffin tin with cooking spray. On a lightly floured surface, roll out crescent dough, and pinch together seams. Cut into 24 squares. Place squares into muffin tin slots.

Step 2 Cut brie into small pieces and place inside the crescent dough. Top with a spoonful of cranberry sauce, some chopped pecans, and one little sprig of rosemary.

Step 3 Bake until the crescent pastry is golden, about 15 minutes.


