


Hubbardston DPW Bi-Weekly Log



Jan.30, 2022 – Feb.12, 2022

Sun.Jan.30, 2022

- 12:00PM removed snow from the sidewalk area of the school and treated
- Plowed sidewalks and skating ring entrance
- Shoveled around the Slade building, Town clerk's office and library
- Filled resident sand

Mon.Jan.31, 2022

- Clean out snow banking's from intersections
- Opened up the snow dump
- Scraped, pushed back and treated mains where needed
- Lengthened the chain on the plow and put the rear fender back on the 14 F450
- Diagnose hydraulic issue on the 09 Sterling
- Cleaned out the loading dock at the school
- Removed the snow banking at the Slade building for added parking

Tues.Feb.1, 2022

- Started removing the snow banking's at the school for added parking
- Diagnose PTO issue on the 09 Sterling
- Shelfed banking's with the Grader on Rt.68

- Patched a pot hole on Brigham St. Per PD request
- Picked up a dead animal just after Gardner cut-off
- Replaced a u-joint in the steering shaft, check fluids and tighten the alternator belt on the 95 Oshkosh
- Diagnose the battery light on the Grader
- Opened up drains around town

Wed.Feb.2, 2022

- Continue to diagnose PTO issue on the 09 Sterling
- Opened up drains around town

Thurs.Feb.3, 2022

- Opened up drains around town
- Put support backer plate behind the blade on the 21 F550
- Continue to diagnose PTO issue on the 09 Sterling
- Pushed up salt as it arrived

Fri.Feb.4, 2022

- 4:00AM-12:00AM Treated and plowed for the freezing rain/sleet storm
- Filled resident sand
- Replaced the cutting edge on the 04 Mack

Sat.Feb.5, 2022

- 12:00AM-2:00AM Finished plowing and treating all roads per Freezing rain/sleet storm 3" total
- Treated all dirt roads for slippery conditions
- Patched pot holes on Main St. and New Templeton Rd. with the Hot Box
- Filled resident sand

Mon.Feb.7, 2022

- Treated Thompson Rd., Brigham St., Halfrey and Old Princeton Cut-off per McCarthy Bus Company

- Patched pot holes on New Templeton Rd., Main St. and Brigham St with the hot box
- Went to Madigan's for 09 Sterling's PTO parts
- Cleaned up salt windrows in the salt shed
- Filled resident sand as needed
- Replaced plow blade segments on the 18 Freightliner
- Patched the LH rear outside tire on the 15 Freightliner
- Opened up a plugged culvert at Kruse Rd. and Williamsville Rd.
- 6:30PM came in to treat all roads due to freezing rain

Tues.Feb.8, 2022

- Treated the school drop off area and walkways the town offices
- 7:00AM treated all roads for refreeze due to rain
- Patched pot holes on Elm St., Main St. and Barre Rd. with the hot box
- Pushed up salt as it arrived
- Removed the plows
- Filled resident sand as needed

Wed.Feb.9, 2022

- Opened up a culvert on Halfrey Rd.
- Pushed up salt as it arrived
- Mixed up 3-1 sand mix
- Filled resident sand as needed
- Removed the plows
- Cut down two dead trees one on Rt.68 and at the Old Recycle center driveway with the Bucket truck
- Spot treated icy sections on Lombard Rd. and Halfrey Rd.
- Patched pot holes on Elm St., Main St. and Barre Rd. with the hot box

Thurs.Feb.10, 2022

- Patched pot holes on Lombard Rd. with the hot box per resident request
- Upcut trees on Dogwood North/South, laurel St., Geordie Ln., Pitcherville Rd., Underwood Rd. and Williamsville Rd.
- Opened up the drainage on Simonds Hill Rd.
- Removed ice buildup on Lombard Rd. per resident request
