# Mon.Nov.12, 2018

## Tues.Nov.13, 2018

- Delivered Bucket truck to Barre DPW
- Opened up Culvert pipe at the fire pond at #91 Lombard Rd.
- Continue painting the body on the 98 Ford
- Installed School bus turn around signs on Old Westminster Rd. and one lane road ahead on Rt.62
- Opened up drainage around town

## Wed.Nov.14, 2018

- 2:30AM called in for spot sanding and water over the road on New Templeton Rd. at the first swamp
- Picked up 18 Freightliner from Donovan's for warranty work
- Patched Old Princeton Rd. and Cut-off, Simonds Hill Rd., Ed
  Clark Rd., Brigham Rd., New Westminster Rd.
- Picked up leaves at the Rec Field
- Piled 4 loads of salt into the shed as it arrived.

- Welded up broken arm on the York rake
- Ordered batteries for the PD message board
- Getting trucks ready for storm coming
