
#### **Town of Hubbardston Planning Board Benchmarking:**

- On September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019, at a duly posted meeting of the Planning Board, the Board was asked by the Town Administrator to consider which towns should be included in the Town of Hubbardston's Benchmarking data (a set of towns which the Town of Hubbardston would be compared against to facilitate positive growth). The Board was informed that the Finance Committee and Board of Selectmen would be included in the final benchmarking discussion once each board/committee had accumulated their data.
- On October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019, at a duly posted meeting of the Planning Board, the Board discussed the criteria by which they would select their benchmarking towns. The Board decided to select attributes by which they would rate a select group of surrounding towns. The attributes were chosen on the basis of "what makes a town great." The attributes chosen were: Amenities and Arts; Business Opportunities, Municipal Services, Open Space, Schools, Town Center, Workforce Housing.
- The Planning Board then decided that they would have their Admin draw up a chart and each member would, independently, rate each town on the list of the seven attributes on a scale of 1-5 (A ranking of "1 being least attractive or towns that the Board Member would not like Hubbardston to be like. A ranking of "5" being most attractive or towns that the Board Member would like Hubbardston to be like). That list was sent to each member and then returned to the Admin for data compilation.
- Based on that accumulated data, the Planning Board has selected their five towns (shown highlighted below) for inclusion in the Town of Hubbardston benchmarking discussion.

## Methodology:

- Population range MUST be between 2,500 and 8,000
  - Hubbardston ≈ 4,500
  - So ≈ 50% 200% of Hubbardston's current population
- Average Single Family Tax Bill
- Income Per Capita
- EQV Per Capita
- Land Area
- Population Density
- Tax Levy
- Total Budget
- Residential Tax Rate

## Scoring System

- 78 towns met initial population criteria
- Calculation of Z score for each town in each criteria
  - o Value represents the number of standard deviations from the mean in each criterion
- Score was scaled to Hubbardston
  - Subtracted Hubbardston's scores from all other towns' scores
  - Establishes the total number of standard deviations a given town is from Hubbardston for a given criterion
- Score was then assigned its absolute value
  - o "Distance" from Hubbardston is more relevant than in which direction
- Scores were then added across all criteria for each town
  - Hubbardston = 0
  - Range up to score of ~24 (Chatham, Dover, Edgartown)
