GENERAL INFORMATION  
2024**

1. **Scholarship Criteria:** The Country Hen Scholarship Fund has been established to provide scholarships for one or more Hubbardston students graduating from high school that plans to attend accredited colleges or universities, who have resided in the Town of Hubbardston for at least three years, and who has displayed community involvement during high school years.
2. **Amount of Annual Scholarship(s):** The amount of the scholarship(s) shall total \$1000.
3. **Application Requirements:** The application must be submitted to the Hubbardston Select Board by **April 22, 2024**. The application form must be signed by the student and by a parent or guardian. An essay describing the applicant's community involvement during his/her high school years and how this involvement has helped prepare the applicant for a successful college career or an essay on why you should be considered for this scholarship, must be submitted with the application. This essay must be no more than 1000 words.
4. **Application Submittal:** Please be sure to staple all pages of the application form, essay and references together in the upper left corner. Please remember to sign the application form by both the student and the parent/guardian.
