Dinghy Dash! Official contest rules and regulations



- Dinghy must be made from cardboard and duct tape. No flex seal, styrofoam or plastic. Do not coat dinghy in paint or other water proofing materials.
- 2. Dinghy must be fashioned after some style of boat. No paddle or surf board styles.
- 3. Dinghy must be inspected prior to race. Inspections will be held between 9-10 am.
- 4. Fastest time without sinking wins for each category. In the event all dinghies sink in a category, longest time afloat before sinking wins for that category.
- 5. Store bought paddles are allowed.
- 6. All dinghies are human powered only, no motors.
- 7. One captain and up to 3 crew members (4 persons total) are allowed per dinghy to operate in group category.
- 8. Captain and crew in the dinghy MUST wear life vests
- 9. All dinghies must be removed from water and shore. Dinghies are the responsibility of the captain and crew to dispose of properly.
- 10. Captain and crew must all be in the dinghy when crossing the finish line to be counted as non-sinking.
- 11. Judges will vote on dinghy for best sink & most creative vessel.
- 12. Dinghy with longest time to cross finish line receives extended voyage award.
- 13. Judges are the final determining body for contest winners.
- 14. All entries due by August 21st.
- 15. Registration fee's are non refundable.
- 16. 1st place prize is \$150 gift card & 2nd place prize is \$50 gift card for all 3 categories
