The law provides further, however, the voters may vote to authorize a one-year increase in the amount to be raised by taxation to pay for a particular item up to the amount stated in the question. Approval of this question will allow the Town to raise by taxation, outside of the limits of Proposition 2-1/2, the sum of \$100,000 to pay for replacing the Hubbardston Public Library roof. The additional taxing authority is available for just the one fiscal year specified in the question, which in this case is the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018. The question of whether to raise the funds by taxation and appropriate them for this purpose will be considered by the voters at the June 5, 2018 Annual Town Meeting.</p>
