



Hubbardston Public Library Reopening Plan

Beginning Tuesday, August 4, 2020 the Hubbardston Public Library will be open to in-person patrons. The library will be open for in-person services on Tuesdays from 4pm to 7pm and Saturdays from 9am to 12pm.

Here are some safety restrictions necessary for a successful reopening:

- Only allow eight patrons are allowed in the library at one time
- All patrons over the age of two must wear a mask
- All patrons will be required to practice social distancing as much as possible
- The Children's Room toys have been removed
- If the library is at capacity and there is a line outside, there will be a time limit of twenty minutes per patron
- The public computer and copier are available for patron use. If you need to fax something, the library staff will handle it for you. There is no cost for using the computer, but if you print from it, it is \$0.10 for black and white pages and \$0.25 for color pages. The copier is also .10 per page, while faxing is \$1.00 per page
- The staff will clean the bathroom and public use areas frequently

The library staff wants to remain open for our patrons, so if you have a fever, a cough or you just don't feel well, please do not come into the Library.

We are still offering curbside pickup on Mondays and Thursdays.
