

## TOWN ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

**SEPTEMBER 18, 2023** 

First, our **Fire Department and DPW** crews were able to lend mutual aid to the towns of Leominster and Princeton as they dealt with significant damage from recent heavy rains. We are fortunate to have such dedicated first responders who are always willing to help neighboring communities in difficult times.

A friendly reminder that all **Capital Improvement Projects** requests are due by September 28th. Department heads should submit detailed proposals for any equipment, vehicle, building, infrastructure or other needs to be considered for next year's budget.

In other news, the **Veterans Services Officer** now has office hours on Thursdays from 10:30am to 12pm at the Slade Building. Please stop by or call to make an appointment if you need assistance accessing benefits.

We are currently putting together a **Green Communities** grant applications focused on upgrading the library HVAC system and school lighting as projects to improve energy efficiency.

The first working group meeting to address Hubbardston's **structural budget deficit** will be held on September 20th at 4pm. We appreciate the collaboration from all town departments and residents as we work to tackle this difficult issue.

The **Hubbardston Lions Club** has requested that we save the date for Sunday, October 1st at 4:00PM, as they will be hosting a dedication ceremony for a new pavilion in Hubbardston. The pavilion will provide a gathering place for residents and community groups to come together. I encourage everyone to mark your calendars to attend this dedication that the Lions Club has generously made possible through their hard work and fundraising efforts. It promises to be a wonderful afternoon celebrating an valuable new addition to our public spaces in Hubbardston.

As Hubbardston's Town Administrator, I am responsible for maintaining a comprehensive inventory of all town property and assets, as outlined in the Hubbardston Charter. This includes conducting a thorough audit and update of the full town inventory at the start of each fiscal year to optimize insurance coverage, maintenance expenses, and purchasing.

The last complete inventory audit was done in 2019. I am pleased to announce that as of September 2023, I have completed an updated inventory of all Hubbardston town property, assets, and real estate. ## **Public Works Update**



Over the past two weeks from August 27 to September 9, the Hubbardston DPW has been busy with various road maintenance and repair projects around town. Work included grading and paving Birches Rd, mowing cemeteries and parks, hot patching potholes on several roads, replacing lights and fenders on trucks, repairing hydraulic lines, brush mowing along Rt. 62 and other roads, and servicing vehicles. They also assisted the Police Dept by setting up barriers for the road race on Sept 9. After hours, they responded to calls for tree removal on Ragged Hill Rd on Sept 8 and a spill clean up at the boat ramp on Old Princeton Rd on Sept 9. In addition to scheduled road work, the DPW continues to handle routine maintenance and emergency responses to keep the town's infrastructure operating safely.

Hubbardston Fire Department deserves immense recognition for their quick action and skill in handling a dangerous situation. At 9:17AM on September 14. 2023. the Hubbardston Police and Fire Department were dispatched to Hale Rd for a vehicle fire. Upon arrival, they found a propane delivery truck engulfed in flames. Recognizing the potential hazard to nearby residents, the Fire Department requested Rutland Regional Dispatch to issue a shelter in place warning. Thanks to the rapid and proficient response by our firefighters, they were able to extinguish the fire swiftly and the shelter in place could be lifted shortly after. The expert training and fast thinking of dedicated fire crews avoided a far more perilous outcome. Their ability to act decisively and combat this blaze so efficiently protected our community from harm. We are truly grateful for their service and the risks they take for our Hubbardston Fire safety. The Department deserves the highest praise today for this tremendous display of courage, teamwork and duty. We are proud to have such an exceptional group watching over our town. 
